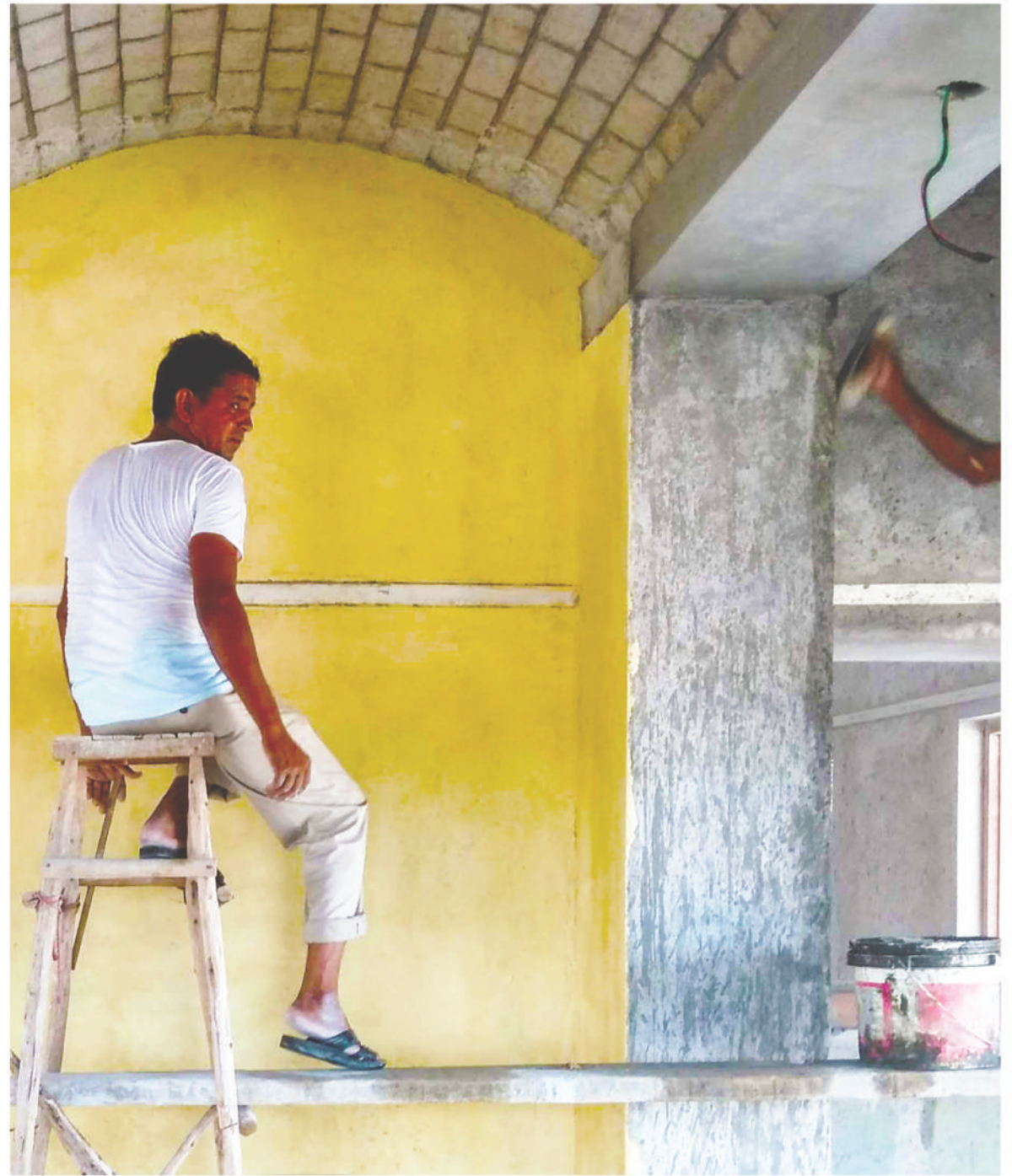

The two day workshop will focus on the techniques of lime mortar and the finishes of Jodhpur and Jaipur's plasters. There will be talks from experts like geologists and discussions on the idea of sustainability (with lime as an eco building) material and its significance.

Beejaram - An artisan from a village near Jodhpur works on the local technique for Lime finish called Kodi marble. He will bring his knowledge to the workshop and teach us the traditional wisdom from his place.
